### Here and There

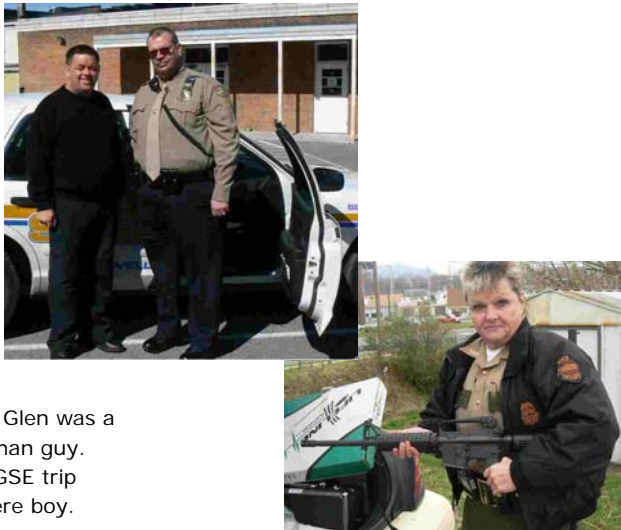
An email from Richard and Sue in Mt Isa. Still looking for red dirt — there's grass everywhere. Off to Broome.
