### Here and there

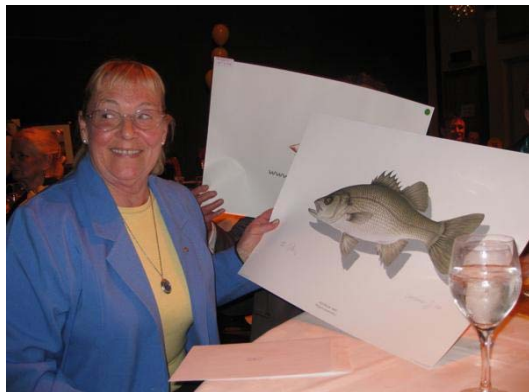
Good to see ADG Ian Smith at our meeting.
